Dear Chamber Member:

On August 4, 2004 Colorado House Bill 04-1125 becomes effective. This legislation prohibits faxing unsolicited advertisements and communication without first obtaining permission from the recipient.

To comply with this legislation, we are requesting that you sign the agreement below and fax it back to the Greater Pueblo Chamber of Commerce. This will serve as authorization for us to continue to communicate with you by fax and email so that you can receive timely communications that pertain to meetings, events, and membership information.

We encourage all of our members to send similar authorization forms to your customers to protect yourself from legal problems and subsequent fines. There are already several law firms that are soliciting the right to collect fees from companies that are not in compliance. Make sure you mail the consent forms as it is against the law to fax or email them.

Please respond as soon as possible so we can continue to communicate with you on upcoming actives.
